4.1 Level AA

1 issue on 1 page

The CSS outline or border style on this element makes it difficult or impossible to see the dotted link focus outline.

Change the style to avoid obscuring the focus outline around focusable elements. Using a border or outline style that obscures the focus ring causes problems for keyboard-only users in:

- Chrome (obscures the focus indicator on links, buttons, dropdowns and range controls)
- Firefox (obscures the focus indicator on links)

• Internet Explorer (obscures the focus indicator on links, buttons and range controls) Internet Explorer and Edge do not support the `outline-offset:` property, so using this does not reliably avoid focus outline overlap.

4.2 Level AAA

1 issue on 1 page

Ensure that text and background colors have a 7:1 contrast ratio.

Some users find it hard to read light gray text on a white background, dark gray text on a black background and white text on a red background. Note: The default link color in IE11 has poor contrast on a white background. Fix by specifying a:link and a:visited colors in CSS.

- The contrast ratio should be 4.5 or more for 18 point text, or larger
- The contrast ratio should be 4.5 or more for 14 point bold text, or larger
- The contrast ratio should be 7.0 or more for all other text

The tel: URL scheme is not supported by some desktop browsers and tablets. On desktops, laptops and devices without a mobile SIM or Skype an error message is usually displayed:

- Chrome on Windows 7 does nothing when the link is clicked
- Firefox on Windows 7 displays the message 'The address wasn't understood'
- IE11 on Windows 7 displays the message 'The webpage cannot be displayed'
- · Chrome on Windows 10 shows a 'Pick an app' window when the link is clicked
- Edge on Windows 10 prompts you use Skype or search for an app in the Windows Store
- Firefox on Windows 10 shows a 'Pick an app' window when the link is clicked

 Chrome on macOS 10.13 launches Facetime which cannot make phone calls unless it's paired to an iPhone

• Safari on macOS 10.13 launches Facetime which cannot make phone calls unless it's paired to an iPhone

- Safari on iPad with iOS 10.2 gives an option of adding a contact or sending a message
- Chrome on Android shows a 'Add to Contacts' window when the link is clicked

The charset attribute on the link element is obsolete. Use an HTTP Content-Type header on the linked resource instead.

8 Usability

This section shows general usability issues, indicating navigation problems for all users.

8.1 Priority 2

1 issue on 1 page

• Omitting img width or height attributes means page text jumps about as images load. This makes the page very hard to read while it's loading, and the user may click on the wrong link if it moves as it's being clicked. Add width and height attributes to the img tag matching the image dimensions. Authoring tools like Dreamweaver can automate this process.
